**RE: *Vote of Confidence!***

Dear Superintendent Arntzen,

We write to refute the unauthorized “no-confidence” letter recently sent to you by certain school superintendents gone rogue. These superintendents spoke with no authority from their local school boards or the parents and students they purport to serve. We remind you and the news media that the superintendents are nothing more than unelected bureaucrats who do NOT represent the people of the state of Montana. The people elected you twice, and we are delighted they did so. We thank you sincerely for the compassionate, professional, and steadfast support you offer to local school boards and, most of all, parents and students. We are so proud of you and the work you do.

The people elected you for a second time as a testament to our approval of your superb performance during your first term. As parents and trustees, we wish to affirm your overwhelmingly positive response to parent and student interests. You have shown courage and endurance in receiving an avalanche of public comments this past year. You have responded with laudable vigor to parents seeking your assistance in pushing back against unelected school officials and their wildly unpopular agenda. You aided parents in resisting superintendent agendas of forced masking and Equity Policies. You helped parents expose and ban pedophilic grooming materials like Gender Queer and Lawn Boy.
